WDIY Announces Additional Programs To Be Aired Monday and Wednesday Evenings

(Lehigh Valley, PA) WDIY 88.1 FM has recently added two locally-produced feature programs to the current on-air schedule. Lore and Legends will premiere Wednesday, November 7th and Season Selections will premiere Monday, November 12th. Both programs will be aired during the 4 o'clock edition of NPR's All Things Considered on WDIY 88.1 FM and WXLV 90.3 FM.

Local historian Frank Whelan, host of Lore and Legends, will produce segments to be aired the first and third Wednesday of each month during All Things Considered, with a repeat segment feature that will air on the 2nd and 4th Sunday of each month during Fresh Air Weekend. Lore and Legends takes a historic look at the Lehigh Valley with the legends that accompany its past.

Season Selections host, Kenn Michael, features an in-depth look at local events as well as arts and cultural institutions and that are not widely known throughout the Valley. The program will air one new feature on the second Monday of each month during NPR's All Things Considered program with repeat segments to air the third Friday of each month.

Tune to WDIY 88.1 FM and WXLV 90.3 FM for more locally produced programs, National Public Radio segments throughout the day as well as public affairs programs and a worldwide variety of musical programming.
